Or volunteer for a phone bank to get other voters looking at the important issues they may otherwise be missing.

### CONTACT YOUR REPRESENTATIVE

Emails, faxes, snail-mail letters, and phone calls to the office of our reps are all ways to let them know that you're watching what they're doing, especially when they're not representing their constituents.



**LATTE LIBRARY!**

Support the local library, at all costs. The freedom of education is key to a democracy and the library is a fragile bastion still holding the line.

**BANNED BOOKS BAKLAVA**

If a book is worth banning, it's probably worth reading. Better yet, donate banned books to encourage other people to read them.

**GET THE LOCAL SCOOP**

Traditional media isn't dead... yet. Whenever possible, read a local newspaper. Even if it's the digital edition. That still helps keep a journalist employed long enough to keep reporting.

**ARTIVISM ALLSPICE**

If you like drawing, painting, crafting, sewing, singing, or just thinking outside of the box, look for "artivism" opportunities, where your art meets social activism!

**VOLUNTEER WITH CUPCAKES**

Volunteering can be as simple as donating a batch of cupcakes to a table at an event, making a pie for a bake sale, delivering meals or groceries.

It's about making connections and sharing your time toward a common goal. Not all volunteer opportunities are "political" and every single one is important to our community.

Start a neighborhood watch, a community garden, or organize a park clean-up to foster a sense of shared ownership and collaboration.

Become a poll worker or an election volunteer, to help ensure that they are fair and accessible for everyone. Rebuild public trust in the systems that form the bedrock of our democracy.
